

Getting to Wimbledon from Stansted Airport

Stansted airport is outside London to the North East and is one of the furthest from Wimbledon



By train

The Stansted Express is a fast and convenient way to and from Stansted Airport. The station is just underneath the main terminal and trains depart every 15 or 30 minutes, with an average journey time of approximately 50 minutes. It costs around **£13**. The train takes you to **Liverpool Street Station**, from there take the underground (Circle Line) to **South Kensington** and change to the District Line (same platform) and wait for a train to Wimbledon. Make sure you get a **Wimbledon train** (it should say Wimbledon on the front of the train) and get off at Wimbledon station, the last stop (around 30 minutes).

From the station we advise you to take a taxi to your homestay, it should cost between **£5 and £10**.



By Coach

The airport coach station is located just underneath the main terminal. The A6 to London Victoria (Central London) connects Stansted Airport with **London Victoria** Coach station. It operates up to every 20 minutes - 24 hours a day. It costs **£10** one way. From Victoria Coach station walk ten minutes to **Victoria Underground station**. Then take the Underground (District Line) to Wimbledon. Make sure you get a **Wimbledon train** (it should say Wimbledon on the front of the train) and get off at Wimbledon station, the last stop. (around 30 minutes)

Single fare is **£4** (cash).

Single fare with an Oystercard **£2.50** (Saturday/Sunday/Bank Holidays)*

From the station we advise you take a taxi to your homestay, it should cost between £5 and £10.



By Taxi

Airport Carz have a desk on the international arrivals concourse. Should you wish to book a taxi in advance please telephone +44 (0) 1279 662444 or alternatively courtesy phones are situated in the International and United Kingdom baggage reclaim halls. The cost of a taxi to Wimbledon is around **£120**.
